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Core Surgical Modules

- **Instruments and Equipment**

- Hands-on familiarisation with rigid endoscopes (transnasal/transorbital setups, camera and light-source handling) and intraoperative navigation - registration, real-time tracking, and landmark confirmation

- **Orbital/Fat Decompression**

- Surgical and radiological anatomy
- Cadaveric practice of medial wall, lateral wall and floor decompression for Thyroid Eye Disease
- Focus on key landmarks, safe zones, and pitfalls - ethmoidal arteries medially, infraorbital nerve at the floor.
- Demonstration of navigation and endoscope-assisted decompression
- Intraoperative use of Navigation & Endoscopy

- **Strabismus Surgery in TED**

- Principles of surgical sequencing - why strabismus surgery follows decompression and eyelid surgery, and how to time it against disease stability
- Covers muscle recession and adjustable suture techniques for restrictive strabismus

- **Eyelids Surgery**

- Techniques for upper and lower lid retraction repair (graded recession, spacer grafts, suture methods for symmetric lid position), lid contouring for shape and crease
- Exposure management



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
